

DC50/60 Keypad - Quick Start Guide

1 Set a user code

To set the user code you have to enter programing mode. To enter programing mode you need to use a Master Code.

Enter

0000 *

Use your own master code if the factory set code was changed

FACTORY SET MASTER CODE

8900# SINGLE USER MODE CODE Use this setup if you need max. 2 users operating the keypad

Single user mode is factory set default mode.

1 is the location for the first user code X X X X

set user code 1 <u>#</u> is to confirm.

* Exit programing mode.

2 Change the lock relay time 01-99 seconds

QQQQ * Use your own master code if the factory set code was changed
