# The new T-line hands-free video doorphone: a streamline design to furnish with style.



Once again, Bitron Video has invested on design and called architect Francesco Trabucco to style the new T-line hands-free video doorphone.

The slim shape of the device is accented by the dark polycarbonate surface spanning over the liquid crystal display and along its entire length.

**Extremely thin (200 x 124 x 38 mm, wall mounted version) the new T-line hands-free device may be embedded using a simple kit, in which case, it protrudes by only 16 millimetres.**

The clean cut of the T-line hands-free video doorphone is a stylish complement to all homes, bringing a modern touch and all the technology you need to operate in the most sophisticated analogue and digital systems.

The design of the new T-line hands-free video doorphone conceals a standard keys for operating the most important supplementary functions, in addition to the usual audio and door lock release buttons.

**The buttons are all arranged in the central unit and perfectly aligned with the monitor:** the lines are seamless and the buttons remain easily accessible at the same time.

\* **Slim**, with dark polycarbonate cover over the monitor spanning along the entire device.



\* **Thin**, protruding 38 mm (wall mounted version) or only 16 mm (embedded version).

\* **Stylish**, designed by Francesco Trabucco.

## Technology and simplicity.

The new hands-free T-line video doorphone also ensures top class performance. Compatible with all the most common analogue and digital systems (5-wire, Eurobus and B-fast) by means of handy brackets, it is easy to install and even easier to use.

All the main secondary controls are found on the standard keys: differentiated floor call, open door indication, second electric gate lock and staircase light switch.

The call volume can be adjusted to three settings: loud, soft and mute (in which case the call is silent).

The T-line hands-free video doorphone is provided with full-duplex audio so that the preferred operating mode can be selected.

In hands-free mode, the "Audio" button is pressed at the beginning and at the end of the conversation. Alternatively, you may choose to hold it pressed for the entire duration of the call.

Adjustable display contrast, colour and brightness: convenient and simple settings for perfect visibility of the monitor.

**Display Contrast, Colour, and Illumination Regulation:**  
a simple command to regulate the visibility of the monitor.

**A-B-C buttons:**  
these buttons are used to manage auxiliary opening functions (second electric gate, staircase lights, etc.).



**Auto-on button:**  
this is used to switch on the display without having been called to monitor the entrance door.

**"Audio" button:**  
this button is also backlit by a two-colour red/green LED. The button turns red when the mute function is on and green after a call is received to help locate the "Audio" button in the dark.

**Door lock release button:**  
back-lit two-colour LED button. The button lights up red to indicate that the door has been left open and green after receiving a call to help locating it even in the dark.
